

# Glen Eugene Boatright

Funeral for Glen Eugene Boatright, 58, Lawton, will be at 12:30 p.m., Tuesday, at the Whinery-Huddleston Chapel, with Chaplain Jay Lane officiating. Mr. Boatright died Thursday, August 6, 2009, in Lawton. Visitation will be from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. today. Burial will be at 2 p.m. at the Fort Sill National Cemetery, Elgin.

He was born August 29, 1950, in Lawton, to Earnest Eugene and Geraldine Mae (Knight) Boatright. He grew up and attended school in Lawton. He joined the Army on July 16, 1968, in Fort Lewis, Wash.
