Eugene E. Culver, 75, died January 9, 2008 in Lawton, Oklahoma. He served in the U.S. Army with two tours of duty in Vietnam. He retired after 32 years of service. Culver was a member of Vietnam Veterans of America-Lawton Chapter 751.
