

# **MSG (Ret) Charles Wesley 'Son' Daniels, Sr.**

**December 17, 1922 - February 25, 2008**



Funeral for Charles Wesley "Son" Daniels Sr., 85, Lawton, will be at 11 am, Monday March 3, Monday at Galilee Missionary Baptist Church with the Rev. Michael Logan officiating.

Mr. Daniels Sr. died Monday, February 25, 2008, in Lawton. Burial with military honors will be in Fort Sill Post Cemetery under direction of Whinery-Huddleston Funeral Service.

Charles Wesley "Son" Daniels Sr., of Lawton, was born December 17, 1922 in Magnolia, Mississippi to Henry and Iona (Magee) Daniels. He died on February 25, 2008 in Lawton at the age of 85. Services are scheduled for 11:00 A.M. on Monday, March 3, 2008 at Galilee Missionary Baptist Church with Rev. Michael Logan officiating. Burial will follow at Ft Sill Post Cemetery with Full Military Honors. Visitation is scheduled for Saturday, March 1, 2008 from 9am-5pm with the family in attendance from 3-5pm, and on Sunday, March 2, 2008 from 1-5pm.

Charles was born and raised in Magnolia, Mississippi where he graduated from High School. He joined the Army in May 1942 and rose to the rank of Master Sgt. by the time of his retirement in November 1963. He married Ethel M. "Jackie" Porter on April 1, 1945. After he retired from the Army, Charles was employed with the Civil Service at Fort Sill for 20 plus years. He was a past Worshipful Master at the Rising Star Masonic Lodge #18. Charles was an avid reader, and was able to further his education by spending a great amount of time improving himself through books. He also enjoyed time with his family, and was especially proud of his grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, 3 sons, Charles W. Daniels, Jr., Henry Daniels and Ronald M. Daniels; and 2 sisters, Nell Fletcher and Mable Isaac.
