Funeral for retired Sgt. 1st Class Oliver Lee Hight, 73, Lawton, will be at 3:30 p.m. Monday in Becker Funeral Home Memorial Chapel with the Rev. Gerald Green, chaplain of Cornerstone Ministries and Vietnam Veterans of America, Chapter No. 751, officiating. Sgt. Hight died Friday, March 26, 1999 in his home following a lengthy illness.
