John C. Marco died August 27, 2005 in Lawton, Oklahoma. He was born January 5, 1940.

Funeral for John C. Marco, 65, Lawton, will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Westminster Presbyterian Church, Lawton, with the Rev. Mark Henslee, pastor, officiating. Marco died Saturday, August 27, 2005, in Dallas. Arrangements are by Becker Funeral Home.

He was born Jan. 5, 1940 in McAlester to Charlie and Myrtle LaVera Hodson Marco. He attended McAlester Public Schools, graduating in 1958. He entered the Army and served from October 1961 to November 1963. He moved to Lawton in 1963 and married Billie Jean Crowder on December 20, 1964, in Wichita Falls, Texas. She died June 20, 2003. He then married Susie Parr on Jan. 1, 2005, in Lawton. He began working for Milo Gordon Chrysler-Plymouth in July 1968, serving as general manager until his retirement in February 2004. He served as the past worshipful master of Mt. Scott Lodge 540 in 2001 and past worshipful master of Triangle Lodge 548 in 2005. Upon his death, he was a 32nd-degree Mason and Shriner. He was a life member of Vietnam Veterans of America Lawton Chapter 751.
