

# Robert William Orcutt

August 7, 1937 - March 23, 2009



Robert William Orcutt, 71, died March 23, 2009 in Lawton, Oklahoma. The cause of death is unknown. Funeral service will be at 2 p.m. Friday at Lawton/Fort Sill Veteran's Center Chapel with Chaplain Carl Hogue and Harley Davidson officiating. Burial with military honors will be in Fort Sill Post Cemetery under direction of Whinery-Huddleston Funeral Service.

He was born August 7, 1937 in Saint Cloud, Minnesota to the late George Orcutt, Sr. and the late Julia Catherine Lommel Orcutt. He was raised and attended school in St. Cloud, Minn. He joined the Army shortly after graduation and married Heo Keum Soon on December 31, 1963, in Seoul, South Korea. She died in 2003. He served In the United States Army from 1955 and retired with 22 years of service in 1977 which included five overseas tours of duty. He received numerous decorations including a Bronze Star Medal, Air Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster and "V" Device, Army Commendation Medal, and the National Defense Service Medal. He was later employed by Lawton Public Schools as caretaker at Ron Stephens Stadium. He attended church services at the Veteran's Center and Western Hills Church of Christ. He was a member of the Western Hills Church of Christ. He was a Permanently Hospitalized Veteran Member of Vietnam Veterans of America Lawton Chapter 751.
