

# **CW4 (Ret) Clarence E. Peckinpaugh Jr.**

**August 23, 1932 - April 5, 2002**

Funeral for Clarence E. Peckinpaugh, Jr., 69, Lawton, will be at 11 a.m. Tuesday at Whinery-Huddleston Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Videll Yackeschi officiating. Mr. Peckinpaugh died Friday, April 5, 2002, in Lawton. Burial will be at Post Cemetery, Fort Sill.
