Funeral for Sgt. 1st Class David Lloyd Tarr, 75, Lawton, will be at 10 a.m. Monday at Lawton/Fort Sill Veterans Center chapel with Jamie Austin, pastor, officiating. Sgt. 1st Class Tarr died Thursday, November 29, 2007, in Lawton. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery under direction of Comanche Nation Funeral Home.

He was born February 19, 1932, in Boston, to Jack Tarr and Elizabeth Lloyd. He enlisted in the U.S. Army on October 7, 1949, at Fort. Banks, Mass. He served in the U.S. Army for 24 years, retiring at Fort Sill on April 30, 1974. He received the Korean Service Medal with 1 Bronze Service Star, 9 Overseas Bars, the United Nations Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal w/ Oak Leaf, and The Good Conduct Medal w/5 Awards, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Army Commendation Award, and Republic of Vietnam with 60 Device. He was a member of VVA Lawton, Oklahoma, Chapter 751.
