

# CSM (Ret) Thomas H. Thompson

August 20, 1937 - November 11, 2005



SAN ANTONIO — Funeral for Thomas H. Thompson, 68, San Antonio, will be at 10 a.m. Friday at New Life Assembly of God Church, Cache. Mr. Thompson died Friday, November 11, 2005 in San Antonio. Burial will be at Fort Sill National Cemetery under direction of Whinery-Huddleston Funeral Service.

He was born August 20, 1937, in Tenn., to Knoxville, Paul and Nettie Warwick Thompson. He attended Rule High School in Knoxville. He married May K. Colquett on February 1, 1957.
